Not all NFCU members use Active Duty Checking accounts for their military pay deposits. Members with other types of checking accounts will have their pay deposited on the regular military payday.

NFCU Active Duty Checking pay deposit dates are highlighted with a box, and the regular military payday is marked through. NFCU credits anticipated military pay deposits one business day prior to the actual military payday, but because of their posting policies, any pay that would be received on a Monday is available for use on the preceding Saturday. Military paydays are the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month and the 1<sup>st</sup> of the following month. If the 15<sup>th</sup> or the 1<sup>st</sup> falls on a weekend or a federal holiday, the payday is the business day before the weekend and/or holiday.
