Military paydays are the 15th of the month and the 1st of the following month. If the 15th or the 1st falls on a weekend or a federal holiday, the payday is the business day before the weekend and/or holiday. Navy Federal customers who use an Active Duty checking account receive their military pay deposit one business day prior to the actual payday. However, Navy Federal's posting process works overnight, so you can't actually receive a pay deposit on the day after a weekend or holiday. As such, pay deposits that should be posted on the day after a weekend or holiday are actually posted on the day following the previous business day. i.e. if the pay is supposed to be credited on Monday, it will be processed overnight on Friday and be available for use on Saturday.
