

How To Use These Sheets

Use these “bingo” sheets to keep track of the items as they are unloaded off of the moving truck. You will need three to ten of these sheets, depending on the size of your shipment. Use one sheet for the first 100 items, then use a second sheet for items number 100 to 200, then 201 to 300, etc. As each item is unloaded off the truck, the mover will call out the number. It is your responsibility to mark them off of your list. It can be very time consuming to flip through all the pages of your actual moving inventory. Keep it nearby, for reference, but actually mark the items off on this page so that you can check things off as fast as the movers are calling the number.

The best ways to hold these sheets are either stacked on a clipboard, or spread out on a makeshift table (card table, two boxes stacked together, etc.) A pen with a color other than black will help your tired eyes as the day progresses.

Whenever you see anything with damage, or have questions, make lots of notes so that you’ll be able to figure things out and note the correct damages or missing items at the end of the day.
